HEIGHT

Short / medium height / tall

WEIGHT

Skinny / Thin / Slim / Medium weight / chubby / fat / overweight / obese

SKIN

Fair-skinned / Tanned / Dark-skinned

HAIR

He has blond hair → He is blond
She has blond hair → She is blonde
He has grey hair → He is grey-haired
She has red hair → She is red-haired
He has dark hair → He is dark-haired

ORDER OF ADJECTIVES

If you want to use more than one adjective in a sentence:

LENGTH + STYLE + COLOR + HAIR

He has got short curly grey hair

Or

OPINION + SIZE + SHAPE + AGE + COLOR + ORIGIN +
MATERIAL

She has got a beautiful little white cat

She wears big round old red glasses

I have a fantastic new green Chinese wooden table
